### THE HOLY SPIRIT - HIS DEITY & PERSON

1. **The Holy Spirit is a person:** (In Greek, personal pronouns are used - He, Him, etc.)

- a. Greek = *parakletos*- "One called alongside to help", Helper, Comforter, Counselor.

#### 6. When we are saved:

- a. He regenerates us (makes us spiritually alive). John 3:3-8; Titus 3:4-7 \_\_\_\_\_

- c. He brings satisfaction for our needs. John 4:13-14; 7:37-39 \_\_\_\_\_

The Holy Spirit is recognized as God in Acts 5:3,4 and is active upon man, convicting him of sin and guiding the believer into all truth. (John 16:7-11)

#### 7. Summary of the Trinity

- a. Genesis 1:1 - The word for God in Hebrew is Elohim.
  - Singular word for God - El; dual tense - Elah; three or more - Elohim (uni-plural noun).
- b. The doctrine of the Trinity is not explicit in the Old Testament, but it is implied: Genesis 1:26; 3:22; 11:7 \_\_\_\_\_

- c. The doctrine of the Trinity is explicit in the New Testament: Matthew 3:16-17; 1 Peter 1:2; Jude 1:20-21 \_\_\_\_\_

- d. The Bible teaches there is only one God: Deuteronomy 4:39; 2 Samuel 7:22; Isaiah 43:10

- e. Even creation implies the doctrine of the Trinity:
  - Space: Length, width, depth in 1 space.
  - Man: Body, soul, spirit in one man.

In the Holy Trinity we have one God manifested (revealed) to us in three distinct persons, all having the same attributes and all being called God. It is difficult to understand totally; we must accept it by faith.
